

Wayfarers Ltd – Sustainable Procurement Policy

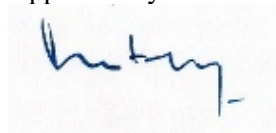
At Wayfarers Ltd, we recognize that every purchasing decision impacts the environment, society, and economy. As a responsible travel company, we are committed to ensuring that our procurement practices support our mission to promote sustainable tourism, protect natural and cultural heritage, and foster local development.

Our sustainable procurement approach:

1. We prioritize products and services that minimize environmental harm, including those that are reusable, recyclable, biodegradable, or made from recycled materials.
2. We avoid single-use plastics and non-biodegradable packaging whenever possible.
3. We prioritize energy-efficient appliances and products certified for environmental sustainability.
4. We give preference to suppliers and service providers that are locally owned and operate within Sri Lanka to support local communities and economies.
5. We encourage our suppliers to adopt environmentally and socially responsible practices, including fair labor conditions and respect for cultural heritage.
6. We engage and communicate our sustainability policies with suppliers who are actively working toward recognized sustainability standards or certifications, and we require evidence where appropriate.
7. We maintain and regularly update a preferred supplier list based on compliance with our policy and ongoing monitoring of supplier sustainability performance.
8. We prioritize goods and services with low carbon footprints, including carbon-neutral certified products and suppliers using sustainable logistics.
9. We provide suppliers with our Sustainable Purchasing Policy or a Supplier Code of Conduct and may require formal acknowledgment and compliance as a condition of engagement.
10. We review this policy annually and update it as needed to reflect changes in industry best practices and organizational goals.
